Our perky little friend comes to life in this 16" x 20" oval stained glass panel because of the careful attention to matching the glass grain to the subject. The leaves and branches also gain depth and realism due to the varying shades of brown and green. The squirrel's eye can be added using black glass or glass paint.

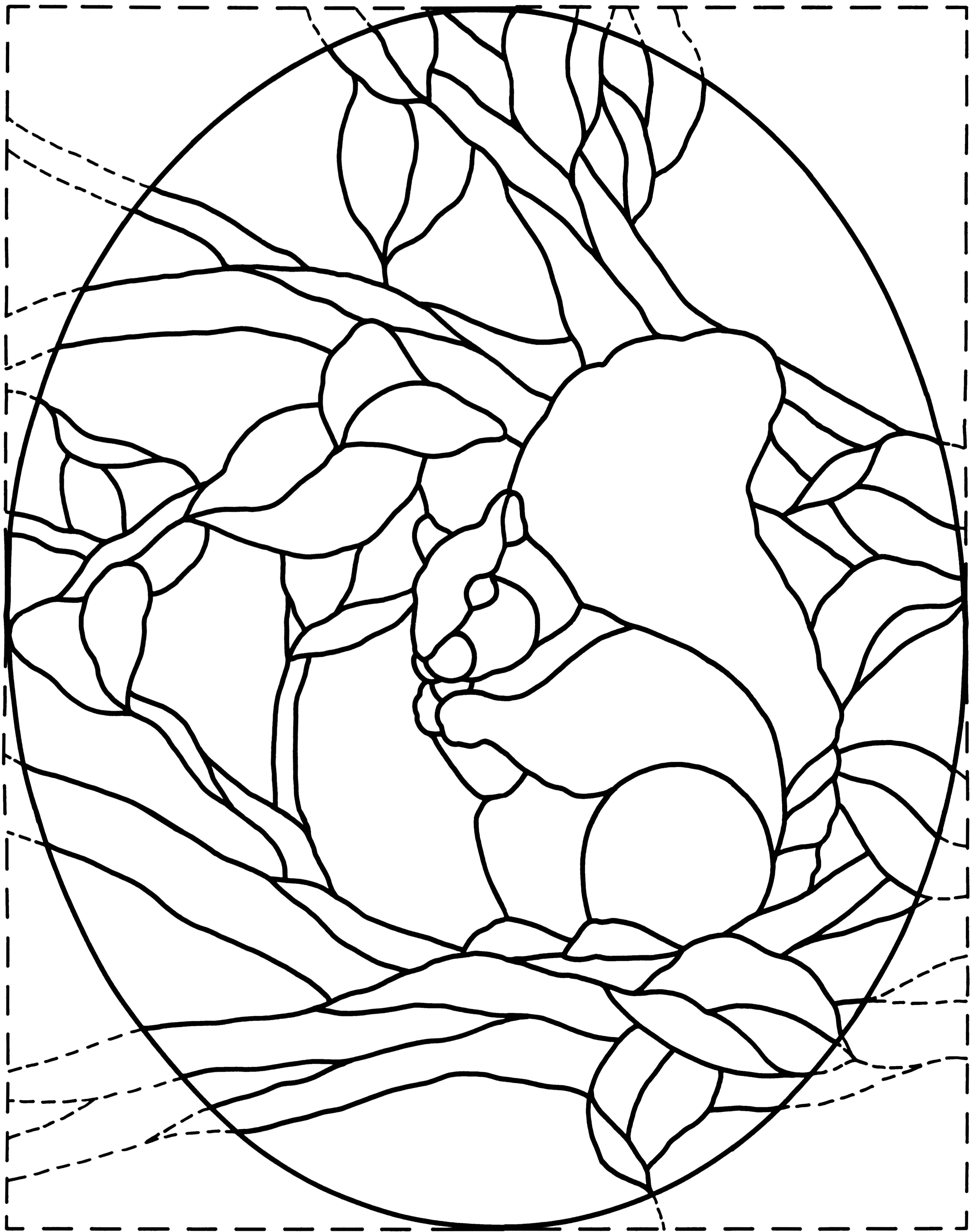

245-L Medium Amber/True Green Streaky/Crystal/Opal for Leaves, 1 Sq. Ft.
