

A Little Girl and Her Frosty Friend

Children and snowmen just seem to go together, and this little girl is no exception as she poses here with her winter handiwork. The texture of her coat, coat trim, and hair plus the snowman's scarf are captured perfectly by carefully matching the grain of the glass to the shape and flow of the pattern pieces. Artists can add the pair's facial features using black glass and copper wire, or they can be painted on with black glass paint.

This 8" x 10-1/2" small panel is from Marianne Crivellaro's book, *Deck the Halls*, one of the twelve pattern collections from *The Ultimate Pattern Book, Vol. 2*. Each volume in this three-book series is filled with full-size patterns and a variety of themes to fit just about any occasion. In Volume 2, besides *Deck the Halls* you'll also find *Adorable Angels*, *From the Heart*, *Florals All Around*, *Mini Victorian Accents*, *Celtic Knots*, and six other pattern books. The patterns also make a great resource for quilters, woodworkers, and card makers.
